Patching & Shimming of Town Roads Specifications

The Town of Winchester, CT is requesting proposals for patching and/or shimming select roads. Mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held on September 8, 2016 at 9:00 a.m. at the Public Works garage 189 Rowley St.

The intent is to patch the deeper holes and shim significant low spots to smooth the surface in order to provide a smoother driving experience and allow better and more efficient snow plowing and help prevent crack referral prior to cracksealing and chipsealing which will be done by others.

Each group of roads will be bundled in the same geographic area of town to minimize mobilization costs.

Town responsibilities:

The Town will pay Galasso Materials, LLC. directly for the bituminous concrete.
The Town will sweep the streets shortly before the contractor comes to patch & shim.
The Town will repair basin tops, manholes and crossover pipes prior to the contractor starting work.

The Town will provide traffic control flaggers.

The Town or others will saw cut or mill keyways of major patches.

Contractor responsibilities:

The contractor will factor into their lump sum price all costs, markups & profit associated with:

- Pick up and delivery of the bituminous from (Galasso Materials, LLC, East Granby, CT) to the streets where it will be placed.
- Equipment, labor and all incidental material costs of safely placing (by hand or machine), raking, compacting, class-2 bituminous concrete to meet the above objectives.
- Feather the shimming material to blend with existing pavement as seamlessly as practical.
- Tack coat the shimmed areas.
- The contractor shall provide a lump sum price for the equipment & labor costs of each group separately and may also give a lump sum for all three groups.
- Multiple contractors may be selected.
- The contractor may include cutting and/or milling keyways for the major patches if so desired.

Mountain Road from Town Line to Peck Road

Taylor Brook Road from Peck Road to Platt Hill Road

Platt Hill Road from South Rd. to Rt. 263

Group B

Willow St. from Rowley St. (Old Rt. 8) to Case Ave.

Prospect St. from Prospect St. Bridge St. to Rt. 263

Meadow St. from Division St. to Rt. 44

Group C

Hurlbut St. from Pratt St. to East Lake St.

East Lake St. from Hurlbut St. to Lake St.

Spencer Hill Road from Manchester Heights to pavement change approximately 2,200 feet.

Peel & Pave

Fehr Avenue from Oakdale Ave. to Glendale Ave.

Remove existing pavement, fine grade and pave with (2) layers of 2" Class 2, 8" curbing on top of base layer leaving 6" curb after the final layer is placed.

Price this as a lump sum quote.

Appendix I

Sec. 147.13a Local Vendor Preference

- A. For all bids and quotes submitted for purchases, exceeding \$3,000 but less than \$1,000,000.00, any qualified and registered local vendor who has submitted a bid or quote not more than 5% higher than the lowest qualified bid or quote will be awarded the contract or purchase order, subject to any limiting provision of this Ordinance, so long as such local vendor agrees to provide the supplies, materials, equipment, commodities and or services which are the subject of such contract or purchase order at the same price as the lowest qualified bid or quote received. In the event that more than one local vendor submits a bid or quote not more than 5% higher than the lowest qualified bid or quote, the award shall be to that local vendor originally submitting the lowest qualified bid or quote.
- B. For purposes of this section, a qualified and registered local vendor is defined as one who maintains a principal place of business within the Town limits of Winchester by occupying real property in which to conduct such business or by paying personal property taxes on business property to the Town of Winchester. Evidence of the maintenance of such principal place of business may include the ownership or long-term lease of real estate from which the principal place of the business is operated or the payment of property taxes on the personal property of the business to be used in the performance of the bid.
- C. The Town Manager shall prepare a local vendor registration form and shall have it made available to all local businesses. When such a form has been properly completed and filed by a local vendor with and approved by the Town Purchasing Agent, such local vendor shall be qualified and registered local vendor in the Town for purposes of this section.
- D. This section shall not apply in any situation where the preference created by this section would violate Federal or state law or any existing contracts.
